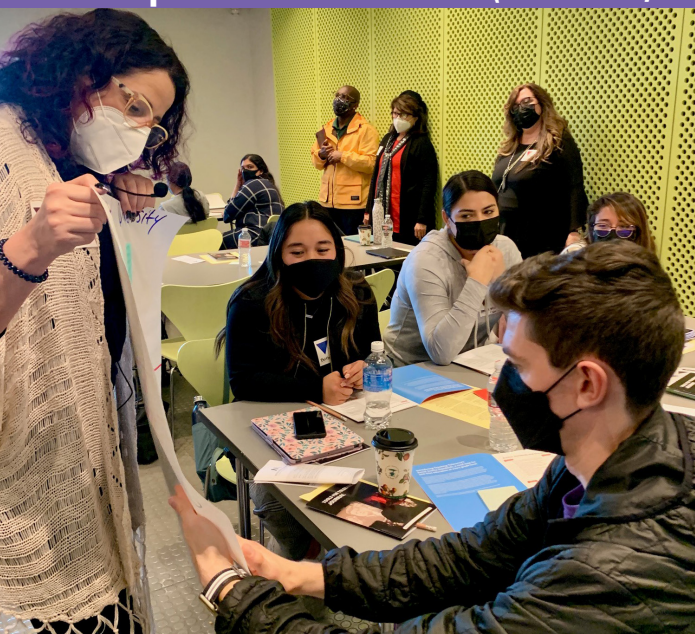

 - * Implicit Bias: Awareness to Action
 - * Cultural proficiency
